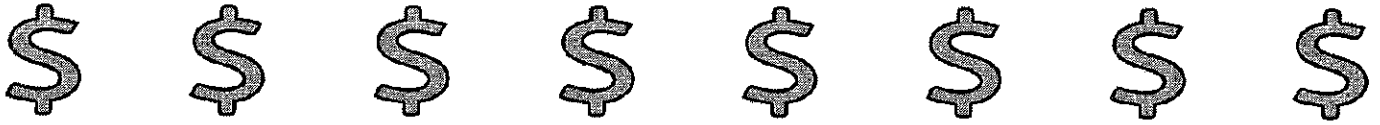

LIST OF OTHER REQUIREMENTS AND INFORMATION ON SCHOLARSHIPS:

Lenora M. Wesley Brookfield-Mardis:

- \$750 one-time award
- Min GPA of 2.0 required
- Copy of high school transcript required
- Resume
- A typed essay on “*How a Scholarship from the St. Louis Public Schools Will Assist Me in Fulfilling My College Goals*”, not to exceed 500 words required
- Two letters of recommendation from school faculty members required

Sol M. Glaser:

- Two (2) \$500 one-time awards
- GPA between 2.5 and 3.0 required
- Copy of high school transcript required
- Resume
- A typed essay on “*How a Scholarship from the St. Louis Public Schools Will Assist Me in Fulfilling My College Goals*”, not to exceed 500 words required
- Two letters of recommendation from school faculty members required

Phillip J. Hickey:

- \$2,750 award for 4 years, totaling \$11,500
- Family income not to exceed \$30,000 (*Family income as established by a W-2 or income tax form- family W-2 for 2009 required and must accompany completed application*)
- Copy of high school transcript required
- Resume
- A typed essay on “*How a Scholarship from the St. Louis Public Schools Will Assist Me in Fulfilling My College Goals*”, not to exceed 500 words required
- Two letters of recommendation from school faculty members required
- Finalists for this award only will be required to participate in a 30 minute in person interview with the scholarship panel at the St. Louis Public Schools Headquarters. Interviews will take place at the end of March/start of April 2010.
- Official College Transcript is required yearly.
